

2022 Sailing Instructions Amendment to Addendum A and List of Marks & Courses

R24 is replaced by a round pink ball pictured below.

- The US Coast Guard has permanently removed mark R24 which we sometimes referred to as “the Windmill Mark”, situated ~1NM south and slightly west of R22. This mark is used in several of our standard courses and is particularly useful whenever we race in medium-to-strong winds from the SSW, which is quite often
 - We have dropped a PBSA mark very close to the (former) location of R24 ~50 yards west of the old R24 location. Its Lat/Long is: 40 55.94 N, 72 27.55W
- The new mark is a round pink ball. It is smaller than the old government mark and is harder to see, appearing clearly at around 200 yards. When navigating to and from this mark, these are some helpful guidelines:
 - It bears 215 degrees magnetic from R22
 - It is 1.24NM from R22
 - Relative to the Shinnecock shoreline, **when viewed along a bearing of 215 degrees**, the mark is:
 - to the right (west) of the windmill, the golf club buildings and all the green land of the golf course
 - in line with a group of 5 or 6 houses that line the shore and which represent the first clear break in the sandy beach that visibly runs from the windmill & golf club to the west
 - just left (east) of a clearly visible antenna that breaks the skyline just west of these 5-6 houses
